THREE TRAYS Checklist

Main		Rescue	Drugs <i>(pre-drawn)</i>
Laryngoscope (check light)	ET CO ₂ device	King Tube / Igel / LMA	Induction agent
+/- video laryngoscope	ET tube securing device	(+/- inflation syringe)	Paralytic agent
2 blades (one larger)	or twill tape	Surgical airway equip't	BP rescue
Magill Forceps	Bite block (OPA)		
3 ET tube sizes (check cuffs)	BVM, mask, O ₂ attached		<u>Maintenance:</u>
Stylet in ET tube	Suction		Sedation
Lube'd tube	Bougie on chest		Analgesia
10mL syringe	Stethoscope		+/- Paralysis

Final Check:

-physiology optimized?	-review drug doses
-ready to switch to nasal prongs	-patient roll is planned/briefed
-3 trays set-up	-BURP prepared
-bougie (on chest)	-C-Spine immobilization if necessary
-suction ready nearby	-IV running well
